Curriculum and Assessment



We offer an Early Years
Foundation Stage
Curriculum
taught through games
and play. The areas of
learning and development are: communication and language;

physical development; personal, social and emotional development; literacy; mathematics; understanding the world; expressive arts and design. Assessments of progress are made within the Early Years Foundation Stage Profile and are reported to parents at the end of each school year.

Hours

We offer 3 hours of funded pre-school provision from 8.50 am to 11.50am Monday to Friday during the school term. Chittlehampton School Breakfast Club runs from 8am – 8.50am and places at breakfast club can be booked through the office and are charged separately from pre-school. Eligibility for



three years olds to receive the Early Years Education Funding is at the start of the term following their third birthday. Unfunded sessions for three

year olds can be booked for £3.82 per hour.
